## **Summary of the 432<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Governing Board**

**Tuesday, 24 May 2022, 10:30 a.m.**

23<sup>rd</sup> meeting held virtually

- President Dietz spoke about the preparations for the 2022 Annual Assembly scheduled for 10 June in Conference Room 3 in the UN Secretariat. It would be a hybrid meeting, with remote login for those who were unable to attend in person. The meeting will once again be moderated by Ms. Deborah Landey who will assist in responding in real time to any questions posed by remote participants. He advised that there will not be a reception following the Annual Assembly this year.
- For the July 2022 FAFICS Council, President Dietz advised that at the special invitation of the Chairman of the Standing Committee for Health Insurance matters, Jay Karia would participate. The members of the AFICS/NY Bureau would participate as usual.
- Following the 28 April GB's discussion on the cancellation of the FAFICS Special Council of 23 May 2022, President Dietz advised that the Bureau had submitted our response and comments to the President of FAFICS as did other FAFICS Member Associations.
- In response to a question raised by Gail Bindley-Taylor on the future plans for the AFICS/NY Office since the DC-1 building would not be rented by the UN after March 2023 as referenced in the previous minutes, President Dietz said that Mr. Nye had advised that Office space would probably be allocated in DC-2 instead.
- Dr. Sudershan Narula updated the GB on the status of the 2022 elections confirming that all was moving ahead smoothly. She confirmed that the results would be announced at the Annual Assembly.
- President Dietz closed the meeting at 12:15 pm.
